The Club Barbecue will be on **Saturday July 20th** at Orchard Cottage, Northlands Road, Warnham RH12 3SQ, at 2.30 pm.

Please provide your own meat. If you would like to bring salads/puddings/drinks etc., please let me know or at the meeting on Wednesday 12th June or 10th July.

We'll also need barbecues, of course: please let me know if you can lend one – they're a rather essential part of the afternoon!

There will be the opportunity to go up the Warnham Lodge Clock Tower. For those of you who are not familiar with it the Clock Tower was built for Henry Harben at the end of the 19th century. It has a water tank that occupies two floors and a very impressive clock. The wonderful views from the very top after climbing about 130 steps of the spiral staircase are of the area between Leith Hill and Chanctonbury Ring.



I hope that lots of you will be able to come. Our club barbecues are always nice relaxing afternoons. If the weather is inclement we can always crowd into the yurt (or the house).

The map below will show you exactly where to go once you get to Northlands Road. Northlands Road is about a mile from Warnham village on the way to Ockley. People using satnavs will probably end up further along the road towards Ockley so be warned! Parking will have to be along the edge of Northlands Rd on the far side to the houses.
